Robert Wright, Jr., (U.S. Air Force Colonel, retired) is the Senior Vice President and General Manager of Integral Systems' Military and Intelligence Group. Before assuming his current role, Mr. Wright served as Commander of the Space Innovation & Development Center (SIDC) at Schriever AFB, CO. The SIDC is the centerpiece of the Air Force's effort to integrate space into its daily operations and provides innovative solutions to warfighters. His long career in space and communications includes

commanding two communications squadrons and a communications group, including a one-year deployed tour supporting Operation Southern Watch and Vice Commander, 14th Air Force (the Flying Tigers). He held several key staff positions, including Executive Officer to the Director, National Reconnaissance Office, as well as aide-de-camp and Executive Officer to the Commander, United States Central Command.
