## Integral Systems buys assets from QinetiQ

**Integral Systems Inc.** bought intellectual property and other assets from **QinetiQ** Group PLC.

The Lanham-based satellite systems control maker (NASDAQ: ISYS) said it bought the services and product line — called satID — from the U.K.-based worldwide defense and security technology company to add geolocation capabilities to its offerings. Satellite operators use satID to geolocate the source of satellite interferers, jammers, and unauthorized users.

Terms of the transaction were not disclosed.

The newly purchased product line and services will become a part of Integral Systems' space communications group.

"We are excited to bring this capability in-house to enhance our space situational awareness product and system offerings for our customers," said John Higginbotham, chief executive officer, Integral Systems, in a statement.

Technology consultancy and other support services relating to the product line will be provided to Integral Systems by QinetiQ in the U.K.

In a different deal, Integral Systems formed an agreement to pursue teaming arrangements with QinetiQ North America on some current programs and to explore future programs for the defense and intelligence markets.
